  - 5. Проблемы экологии. Защита окружающей среды. Стихийные бедствия. Условия проживания в городской и сельской местности;
  - 6. Технический прогресс: перспективы и последствия. Современные средства связи (мобильные телефоны, смартфоны, планшеты, компьютеры);
- 3) Итоговый контроль

Данные виды контроля направлены на проверку навыков аудирования, смыслового чтения и письменной речи, а так же лексический запас и грамматические навыки.
