#### Пояснительная записка

Рабочая программа по английскому в 11 классе рассчитана на 102 академических часа и включает в себя следующие виды контроля:

- 1) Стартовая диагностика
- 2) Тематический контроль по темам:
  - 1. Повседневная жизнь семьи. Межличностные отношения в семье, с друзьями и знакомыми. Конфликтные ситуации, их предупреждение и разрешение;
  - 2. Здоровый образ жизни и забота о здоровье: режим труда и отдыха, спорт, сбалансированное питание, посещение врача. Отказ от вредных привычек;
  - 3. Школьное образование, школьная жизнь. Переписка с зарубежными сверстниками. Взаимоотношения в школе. Проблемы и решения. Подготовка к выпускным экзаменам. Выбор профессии. Альтернативы в продолжении образования;
  - 4. Туризм. Виды отдыха. Экотуризм. Путешествия по России и зарубежным странам;
  - 5. Вселенная и человек. Природа. Проблемы экологии. Защита окружающей среды. Проживание в городской/сельской местности;
  - 6. Родная страна и страна/страны изучаемого языка: географическое положение, столица, крупные города, регионы; система образования, достопримечательности, культурные особенности (национальные и популярные праздники, знаменательные даты, традиции, обычаи); страницы истории;
  - 7. Выдающиеся люди родной страны и страны/стран изучаемого языка, их вклад в науку и мировую культуру: государственные деятели, ученые, писатели, поэты, художники, композиторы, путешественники, спортсмены, актеры и т.д.
- 3) Итоговый контроль

Данные виды контроля направлены на проверку навыков *аудирования*, *смыслового* чтения и письменной речи, а также лексический запас и грамматические навыки.

Все контрольные работы разработаны по лексическому и грамматическому материалам учебников УМК Английский в фокусе «Spotlight» за 11 класс.
